Important Updates From Riverside RV Village

A virtual board meeting was held April 26, 2020.

As an outcome, some important announcements follow.

Construction Work

Beginning May 11, 2020 and for the rest of that week, construction crews will be returning to complete waterline work begun last fall. They will be working near the front gate entrance. Watch for signage and remain clear of the worksite.

Annual General Meeting

Due to COVID 19, the AGM scheduled for June 6, 2020 has been postponed until further notice. Owners will be given proper notice when a new date for the AGM has been scheduled. The current Board of Directors will remain in place until such time as an AGM can be held.

Clubhouse Bookings

Due to COVID 19 restrictions, all clubhouse functions are cancelled for the months of May, June, July and August. Bookings already made will be kept on file and should there be any change to restrictions owners will be contacted.

Park Usage

At this time park usage recommendations remain in place. The Town and Alberta Health Services request that owners do not stay in the park unless it is your primary residence. The washroom and laundry facilities are closed. There are no water or sewer services available for use. If owners wish to check on their units and property they may do so; however, they are asked not to stay in the park as requested.

To Our Fellow Albertans and Visitors,

We are writing to you as a friend, a host and a neighbour requesting your consideration before you travel to our area during this difficult time. Many people have vacation homes, part time residences and recreation or seasonal lots in our town and in Mountain View County. You may find Mountain View County and Sundre as a beautiful place to escape, relax and unwind. We appreciate all that you bring to our area and your contributions to our town.

This is a stressful time with the threat of COVID-19 spreading throughout Canada. Closures of Schools, and Recreation facilities, cancellation of trips planned months in advance, all lead to a desire to find a place to escape. We would like to request at this time that before you visit us you consider that we have a small hospital and a limited number of doctors and medical staff that cover the emergency department, clinics, and hospital in-patients.

Our town is small and isolated and our closest other healthcare facilities will likely be strained with regional cases. Transport of patients between Sundre and other municipalities can be difficult at the best of times and moving Covid-19 patients will put many emergency health care providers at risk.

We are doing what we can to ensure we are able to provide essential services to our residents and an increase in population or visitors could put those staff and service providers at further risk.

Throughout the year, summer months, winter holidays, and long weekends we are honoured to have you visit our County and town. During this time though we ask that you remain home and do your part to limit the spread of the COVID-19 virus and the potentially very serious illness that comes with it.

We thank you for your consideration and allowing us to focus on giving our local residents and community the best possible care.
